Sustainable Shared Growth refers to rapid economic growth that is at the same time equitable and environmentally-friendly. While the world has experienced unprecedented economic growth, this has come together with increasingly unacceptable costs from widening disparities in wealth/income, as well as environmental degradation.

This conference adopts an interdisciplinary, intersectoral, and international approach to the vision of achieving Sustainable Shared Growth. It seeks to understand the various mechanisms that prevent or promote Sustainable Shared Growth from varied lenses, in the hope of finding paths towards fulfilling its vision.
