

QUEZON CITY TOUR



La Mesa Eco Park: a 33-heactare ecological park that is part of the 2,700-hectare La Mesa Nature Reserve which protects La Mesa Dam, Metro Minla's chief water reservoir. It is a wild jungle carved into a forested recreation park that features towering trees, botanical gardens, camping grounds, educational facilities and several sports activities.

Quezon Memorial Park: a national park and shrine located in Quezon City, the former capital of the Philippines (1948–1976). Its main feature is a mausoleum containing the remains of Manuel L. Quezon, the second President of the Philippines.

Art in Island: one of Asia's largest 3D Interactive/Trick Art Museum housing over 50 kinds of 3D paintings with varied themes. So many photo ops of illusion and fun!
