ALLÍ (pronounced <u>al - YEEH</u>) is a product of the University of the Philippines (UP) College of Architecture (1982) and of the UP School of Urban and Regional Planning (1994). He has had more than thirty (30) years of progressively responsible/ diversified experience in the professional practice of the architectural and allied design professions, particularly in the fields of land use, site, physical, transportation, and environmental planning, environmental design, general consulting, professional practice regulation, construction arbitration and mediation, volunteer government service, architecture advocacy, the project management of consulting services and the crafting of national laws and regulations that concern the management and use of the built environment.
