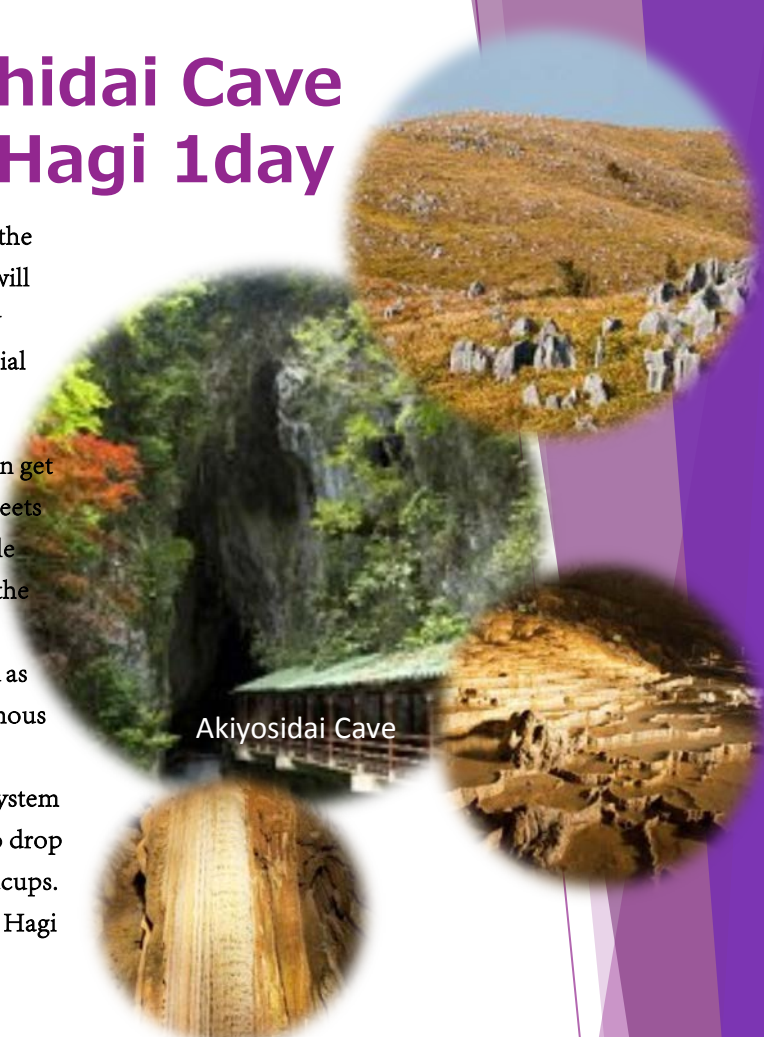


Tour of Akiyoshidai Cave and Old Town Hagi 1day

This tour will visit Akiyoshidai Cave which is one of the largest limestone caves in Asia. The forty-minute tour will take you 100 meters underground where you will enjoy many amazing rock formations presented under special lighting.

The tour will continue to Hagi town where visitors can get a feeling of the samurai era in Japan as they walk the streets in the old town. On this tour we will visit Tokoji Temple with its garden of 500 stone lanterns, and walk around the old town called Kikuyayokocho. There we will drop in several merchants' homes, which have been preserved as museums and see their lovely gardens. Hagi is most famous as the home of several of the founders of the Meiji Restoration (1867-1868), which ended Japan's feudal system and brought Japan into the modern world. We will also drop in a Hagi pottery kiln to decorate our own Japanese teacups. You will be able to take the teacups home as souvenirs. Hagi is one of the most famous pottery areas in Japan.



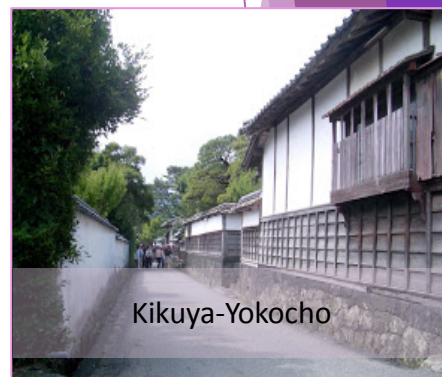
