About the Asia Future Conference

The Asia Future Conference (AFC) is international and inter-disciplinary at its core and encourages diverse approaches to global issues that are mindful of the advancement of science, technology and business while taking into consideration issues of the environment, politics, education, the arts, and culture. The aim of the AFC is to provide a space to discuss these multi-faceted issues. The AFC is hosted by the Sekiguchi Global Research Association (SGRA) with the support and cooperation of a number of institutions and organizations. The conference takes place biannually and is held in a different location in Asia each time. To date, each conference has seen over 500 participants from over 20 countries take part. The conference hosts symposiums and roundtable sessions based on a specific theme and provides a space for young scholars to present their research in parallel sessions. Best Papers are selected from the papers submitted and published in an edited volume, and AFC scholarships are also provided to give young scholars from various Asian countries the opportunity to participate in the conference.

Aim of the Conference

The twenty-first century has seen the world thrust into a maelstrom of change and unpredictability. We remain hopeful in the face of rapid technological advancements, but many of us struggle to regain our bearings as longstanding social structures become upended. Internationalization and globalization have long been heralded as the keys for the future, yet a truly global path forward remains elusive, serving only to heighten the sense of uncertainty. As global citizens in this era of change, we are called anew to reexamine our world and our collective future and to seek new multidimensional and inclusive perspectives on myriad global issues.

Rapid economic development has led to dramatic changes in Asia. The widening gap between the rich and the poor, climate change, the recent Covid-19 pandemic, and the unstable international order caused by the rise of nationalism and the threat of war have all created a series of challenges that transcend national boundaries and for which solutions are extremely difficult to find. The citizens and groups that make up society must think not only about the pursuit of individual wealth, but of the benefits for the rest of society. To solve these varied contemporary issues, it is necessary to cross and cooperate across national and disciplinary borders, and to analyze issues from a multidimensional perspective.

The Asia Future Conference was established with this reality in mind. International and interdisciplinary at its core, the Asia Future Conference encourages diverse approaches to global issues that are mindful of the advancement of science, technology and business and take into consideration issues of the environment, politics, education, the arts, and culture. The Asia Future Conference is organized by the Sekiguchi Global Research Association (SGRA) in partnership with likeminded institutions, and provides a venue for the exchange of knowledge, information, ideas, and culture not only for SGRA members, but also for former international and local students of Japan from educational institutions around the world, their own students and collaborators, and anyone interested in Japan.

SGRA began operating in Tokyo in July 2000 as a division of the Atsumi International Foundation, a charitable organization. At its core is a community of international researchers who come from all over the world to conduct advanced studies in Japan as well as Japanese researchers who obtain doctoral degrees from Japanese graduate institutions. SGRA identifies current social, economic, cultural, as well as other issues in various fields and seeks to disseminate research results to a wide audience through forums, reports, and the internet. SGRA's aim is to reach society at large rather than a specific group of specialists through wide-ranging research activities that are inherently interdisciplinary and international. The essential objective of SGRA is to contribute to the realization of responsible global citizens.

Garnering the support and cooperation of various like-minded institutions, the 1st AFC was held in March 2013 in Bangkok, Thailand, the 2nd in August 2014 in Bali, Indonesia, the 3rd in September 2016 in Kita Kyushu City and the 4th in August 2018 in Seoul, South Korea. The 5th AFC was most recently held in Manila, the Philippines, in January 2020. All of the conferences were made memorable by the many passionate presentations as well as fruitful exchanges that took place.

The 6th Asian Future Conference was scheduled to be held in Taipei in August 2021 with the Chinese Culture University as co-organizer, but due to the global outbreak of Covid-19, it was postponed by a year and instead the one-day 6th Asian Future Conference Preconference was held online on August 26, 2021. And now, even though the pandemic is far from over in Asia, the 6th Asia Future Conference will be held in a hybrid format of on-site and online participation at the Chinese Culture University in Taipei from August 27 (Sat.) to 29 (Mon.), 2022. Asia and the world are at a major turning point. We hope that the 6th Asia Future Conference will provide an opportunity for invigorating discussions on the future of our global society.

Selection Procedure of the Best Papers

There are a total of 133 submissions (111 in English, 16 in Japanese, 6 in Chinese) for AFC#6B Best Paper selection. Based on the Topics and Keywords chosen by the authors at the time of registration, submissions were divided into 12 groups, and 6 reviewers read each group.

Reviewers were asked to evaluate based on the following five criteria.

1. Thematic relevance: 16%

Does this paper fit with the theme: "BUILDING A FUTURE ASIA — Solving Problems, Together"?

2. Structure and readability: 14%

Is this paper structured and easy to comprehend?

3. Cohesiveness and persuasiveness: 14%

Is the argument clearly presented and persuasive?

4. Originality: 14%

Is there a clear statement of a gap in existing research that this paper seeks to fill? Is the method used in the paper to fill this gap creative?

5. International: 14%

Is this paper international in breadth and scope - examines the issue from different cultural contexts and/or from a global perspective?

6. Interdisciplinary: 14%

Is this paper interdisciplinary - it presents ideas that can be applied to different fields, as well as discusses how research is relevant in various disciplines?

7. Overall Recommendation: 14%

Minus point were given if a paper does not follow the Paper Format Guide.

At the end, the reviewers were asked to recommend two Best Paper candidates from the set of papers assigned.

From the synthesis of reviewing results, the top 20 were selected for the Best Papers, based on the number of recommendations. If the number of recommendations is the same, then those with higher scores were selected.

International Infectious Diseases and Taiwan - Coexisting with COVID-19 or Zero-COVID?

Since the outbreak of COVID-19 in Wuhan, China in December 2019, pandemic prevention for COVID-19 can be divided into three major phases, with the successful launch of the vaccine in December 2020 and the global spread of the Omicron variant in December 2021 as the cut-off points. In the first phase, the pandemic could only be prevented by non-pharmaceutical interventions (NPI) that interrupt the transmission of the virus, including home quarantine for people entering infected countries/areas, isolation of confirmed cases, home isolation of close contacts, and implementing hygiene measures. In the second phase, after the vaccine was released, it became possible to enhance herd immunity and reduce cases through universal vaccination, along with continuous implementation of NPI. In the third stage, after the spread of the Omicron variant, the "Zero-COVID tolerance" policy must be modified to a "coexistence" policy. In addition to continuing to improve vaccine coverage and NPI measures, it is necessary to provide universal access to rapid screening services and antiviral medication in the community, and to enhance the treatment of moderate and severe cases in medical institutions. Since the first confirmed case in Taiwan entered the country from Wuhan on January 21, 2020, the government and the community have been working together to prevent the epidemic, with the characteristics of "prudent action, rapid response, early deployment, transparency and openness, and unity of all people", establishing Taiwan's successful model of epidemic prevention which kept the total case number at zero for a long time. By the end of 2021, Taiwan had the lowest cumulative number of confirmed cases per million population and the second lowest cumulative number of confirmed deaths per million population (after New Zealand) compared to OECD countries and Singapore, and has maintained a GDP growth of over 3% in 2020. This result, which many other countries strive to emulate, was only made possible by a virtuous cycle of good governance and good citizenship.

He has served as Director of the Secretary's Office at National Taiwan University (NTU), Head of the Department of Philosophy at NTU, and member of the Advisory Committee for the Promotion of Life Education, Ministry of Education. He is currently Special Assistant to the President of NTU, Professor in the Department of Philosophy and Director of the Research and Development Centre for Life Education at NTU, and Director of the Research and Development Centre for Life Education at the Ministry of Education.

◆ Important Life Lessons Learned from the Pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic makes people reflect on their life from different perspectives. 1) Impermanence and meaning: A lot of people rethink the meaning of life. 2) Determining the rightness and fairness and making value judgment: The pandemic forces us to make various choices. Individuals and countries need to make decisions after weighing the pros and cons of the situation objectively and considering the rightness and values. 3) Disease prevention has made people distant from one another. It is a very important lesson for individuals and institutions to learn to improve communication and engage in mutual support. 4) Collectivist societies emphasize life education, which is the core of holistic human development. COVID-19 made many people experience impermanence, explore the meaning of life, and rethink their values. The pandemic taught us to pay more attention to life education. Therefore, we should revisit the essence of education in holistic human development to cultivate future talents with character, vision, and empathy.

"I understand the unprecedented global crisis caused by COVID-19 pandemic from the perspective of "emerging security," predicated on the theoretical resources of complexity.

Looking at South Korea as a model of new forms of international and regional cooperation, I propose the development of the institutional mechanism of "meta-governance."

◆ COVID-19 and Korea: From the Perspective of Emerging Security and Meta-governance

COVID-19 has created a new concept of "health security" in terms of being part of security in international relations, no longer just in the medical field. Unlike the security risks that have been assumed by security in the past, this is a typical example of "emerging security," a concept of complexity theory. At the micro level, it may be a simple personal health problem, but if it increases quantitatively and exceeds certain thresholds, it becomes a health issue at the local and national levels, and furthermore, it becomes a problem enough to discuss national security as it is linked to issues such as economy, society and diplomacy. I would like to propose a new policy for COVID-19 from a "meta-governance" perspective that emphasizes the participation of multiple actors and mechanisms for resilience and flexible response, by introducing the Korean experience.

Reflection on Humanity, Strength, and Transformation amid COVID Crisis.

Over the past two years, Taipei City Hospital has demonstrated its perseverance in fighting the COVID-19 pandemic at different stages. Following Taipei City Government’s COVID-19 Epidemic Prevention SOPs, the Hospital has been responsible for disease screening and quarantine, diagnoses, vaccination and medical services. The Hospital partnered with private enterprises to develop a cloud-based system that utilizes open source technologies such as modularization, standardization, digitization, and diversification. The system allows government agencies, hospitals, and medical professionals to work together and share the latest information in order to fight the disease effectively. Innovations are made to fulfill human needs. Applying digital technology to bridge the information gap among hospitals and health departments has allowed relevant units to respond to the pandemic and conduct screening and quarantine in time. As a result, the infection could be stopped, and people could return to pre-pandemic life soon.

Response to COVID-19 in Japan and Future Prospects

The distinctive feature of Japanese laws on infectious diseases is that they do not strongly regulate the behavior of the citizen. In fact, the public has often followed the government's recommendations on infection prevention and taken risk-averse actions on their own. As a result, the degree of infection has been controlled to a certain degree, and to date the number of deaths has been kept low compared to Western countries. How to aim for a way out in the future needs to be discussed.

In the case of Japan, the vaccination rate is high but the cumulative incidence rate is low. This means that if infection control measures are relaxed all at once, a large number of infected people will occur and cause great damage to society. Japan's measures to reduce the number of deaths and to restore economic activity should be emphasized as a different approach from those taken in countries with high morbidity rates.

International Academic Exchange during the COVID-19 Pandemic:

A Case Study of Chinese Culture University

COVID-19 has severely impact on higher education internationalization plans due to a decrease in students' global-mobility (global-mobility). According to the data of April 2020 from the Studyportals, an online education service platform in the Netherlands (StudyPortals), 40% of the students who planned to study aboard changed their plans. As the pandemic continues, we still can't foresee the end of this difficult situation, but need to discuss how will international exchange and infectious diseases coexist, and whether the response to COVID-19 can be a new model for international exchange in the post-coronary era? We need to keep an eye on this matter.


